Players should always ensure that appropriate footwear is used and that spikes or cleats are in good condition. Players should also be aware of the use of the warning word FORE and the dangers of possible errant golf shots played by yourself or other users of the course.

Players are also advised to leave the course in the event of dangerous weather conditions including lightning or the potential of lightning as well as fog or conditions were they are unable to see other users such that they cannot make a safe decision to hit their next shot or continue playing safely.


